



## How to collect your silage wrap & twine for recycling

## Silage wrap/film and polypropylene (PP) twine only

- Use **separate** clear bags only Do not mix wrap & twine together **Clear** bags only
- Shake off dirt and moisture before bagging.
- A little hay is OK, but no rocks, steel, dirt or dead furry animals!
- Bags must be tied off with PP twine or a cable tie if desired not wire!
- Keep the bags **dry**, inside or undercover if possible.

Silage mesh/netting, grain bags, mulch film, woven PP feed bags, silage film on rolls, PP bulka bags, drums, nylon, polyester, multilaminate films, PVDC, hard plastics, PVC & HDPE tarpaulins, or aluminium foil lined films.
