How to collect your silage wrap & twine for recycling


 YES	<p>Silage wrap/film and polypropylene (PP) twine only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use separate clear bags only - Do not mix wrap & twine together – Clear bags only • Shake off dirt and moisture before bagging. • A little hay is OK, but no rocks, steel, dirt or dead furry animals! • Bags must be tied off with PP twine or a cable tie if desired - not wire! • Keep the bags dry, inside or undercover if possible.
 NO	<p>Silage mesh/netting, grain bags, mulch film, woven PP feed bags, silage film on rolls, PP bulka bags, drums, nylon, polyester, multilaminate films, PVDC, hard plastics, PVC & HDPE tarpaulins, or aluminium foil lined films.</p>
