How to collect your silage wrap for recycling

 YES	<p>Silage wrap/film only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use separate clear bags only - Do not mix wrap & twine together – Clear bags only• Shake off dirt and moisture before bagging.• A little hay is OK, but no rocks, steel, dirt or dead furry animals!• Bags must be tied off with PP twine or a cable tie if desired - not wire!• Keep the bags dry, inside or undercover if possible.
 NO	<p>PP twine, Silage mesh/netting, grain bags, mulch film, woven PP feed bags, silage film on rolls, PP bulka bags, drums, nylon, polyester, multilaminate films, PVDC, hard plastics, PVC & HDPE tarpaulins, or aluminium foil lined films.</p>
